17TH ANNUAL HEMLOCKFEST RETURNS IN NOVEMBER 2022 MUSICAL LINEUP AND NEW VENUE ANNOUNCED

DAHLONEGA, GA – September 1, 2022 - The Lumpkin Coalition is happy to announce the return of HemlockFest, celebrating its 17th year with a new venue and confirmed music lineup. The three-day, two-night festival will take place November 4-6, 2022, at Cherokee Farms in LaFayette, GA.

HemlockFest is a music, camping, arts & crafts, and environmental action festival held the first full weekend in November. The event aims to engage the eco-conscious, music-loving community, raising awareness about, and funds supporting research in, the battle to save North Georgia's and Southern Appalachia's hemlock trees from the destructive Hemlock Woolly Adelgid.

"HemlockFest is about the cause first with the music, vending, and camping being the icing on the cake," said Forest Hilyer, chairman of the Lumpkin Coalition, a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit whose mission is to facilitate projects promoting a clean and healthy environment, responsible living, and responsible growth.

"In addition to raising money to support efforts combating the Hemlock Woolly Adelgid, we also want to raise awareness about the importance of saving the Hemlock trees in our southeastern forests. The destruction of this important species has a variety of catastrophic effects, including increased stream temperatures and increased algal growth, resulting in fewer fish like trout and other native species, aquatic insects, salamanders, and crawfish. Hemlocks also provide a dense canopy that helps prevent erosion and maintains moisture in the forest floor," Hilyer said.
